We cordially invite you to participate in the International Conference "Research and Practice in Forest Ecology", organized by the Institute of Dendrology, Polish Academy of Sciences, in Kórnik, Poland, on 8-12 May 2024.

The aim of the Conference will be to discuss the results of research in the field of forest ecology, including changes in forest ecosystems in local, regional and global terms, as well as to outline directions and perspectives for new research (including interdisciplinary studies) and to establish cooperation between research centers.

The Conference is addressed to young scientists: students, PhD students and researchers with doctoral diploma up to 7 years after graduation.

inaugural plenary session will include keynote lectures delivered by researchers of the Institute of Dendrology, Polish Academy of Sciences. researchers Presentations by young will be selected from the submitted abstracts.

GENERAL CONFERENCE PLAN:

1st day (8 May) – leading lectures

Leading lectures of the inaugural session will be presented by the scientific staff of the Institute of Dendrology, Polish Academy of Sciences, who are specialists in the field of ecology of forest ecosystems, symbiotic associations, the biological basis of plant reproduction and dispersion, and population genetics of forest trees.

2nd day (9 May) – presentations of young researchers

The speakers will be selected by the Conference Scientific Committee based on abstract submitted by the Conference participants.

3rd day (10 May) – workshops

The workshops will be organized in the laboratories of the Institute of Dendrology in the four following thematic blocks: 1) ectomycorrhizal fungi from fruiting body to DNA sequencing, 2) in vitro propagation of plants, 3) population genetics of forest trees, 4) woody plants species recognition.

 $4^{th}-5^{th}$ day (10-12 May) – field excursion to the Stołowe Mountains National Park.
